#### TASTING NOTES

Light salmon in color, vibrant aromas of strawberry and rose. Bright and lively acidity, with a round, fruit driven mid-palate. Notes of rhubarb, and a hint of red grapefruit; followed by a crisp, clean finish.

## **VINEYARD NOTES**

Harvested in September 2023. Combination of a warmer site consisting of Yakima Valley and Wahluke Slope, and cooler site with higher elevation in the Ancient Lake bringing natural acidity and minerality.
